




Making your own badges

Materials and procedure	Illustration of procedures
<p>Computer, Design program,.e.g. word-paint or photoshop, computer,printer, scanner, stapler, hammer, cardboard, safety pins length a little less than 4,5 cm, printer paper,cardboard, glue, varnish glue,</p>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Print sheets with as many circles as you need badges,diameter e.g. 4,5 cm 2. Glue the sheets with circles to cardboard of scissorable thickness. Cut out the cardboard circles. 3. Print your badge motives in the same size circles.Do not paste them yet! 	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Fix the safety pins (openable edge up) to the cardboard circles using cut oblongs of duct tape. Hold them securely in place by stapling on each side of safety pin (white lines) 5. (right)Showing other side with stapled pins. Note staples not flush with surface 	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6. Place the badge face down on a hard disposable surface. Hammer the staples until they are flush with the surface on the other side. 	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 7. Glue the badge motif (here Willam after Ghilandaio's Visitation). After drying finish with one or 2 coats varnish glue.
